ATTENDANCE ... Remember... Every Day Counts!

Going to school every day is the most important part of your child's education. Students learn new things at school every day – missing school puts them behind.

In primary school, some students **miss** on average **4 days a term**, which is **3 weeks** of school **per year**. That's **half a year** of school by the end of **year 6**.

We know there are always times students need to miss school because they are ill. Setting good sleep routines, eating well and exercising regularly can make a difference too.




