Class Placements 2024

Shortly the teaching staff will be working through the rigorous process of regrouping and placing students into new grade for 2024. A number of considerations are made when determining new grades. These include:

- A balanced number of children in each grade
- A balanced number of boys and girls (enrolment dependent)
- A balanced number of academic, social and emotional needs.
- An appropriate mix of role models and leaders
- An appropriate placement of students with additional needs
- · Friendships groups

All children are given the opportunity to write the names of friends with whom they would like to be in the same class. It is explained to the children that attempts will be made to place them with at least one other friend.

Teachers will spend a considerable amount of time working through this process. This will be followed up with transition sessions with the children whereby further adjustments and refinements will be made.

All teachers at Moomba Park Primary School are caring and committed educators and Moomba Park Primary School strives to ensure that all students are provided with a high-quality education.

Whilst we appreciate that you may wish that your child would benefit from being placed in a class with a particular teacher, we are generally unable to accommodate these requests. Our school's Principal Class team have an in-depth understanding of each teacher's strengths and will always endeavour to place our students with teachers who are best placed to suit their needs.


